## Part of Speech & Structure

- It's (an adjective / a gerund / a noun / a verb).
- It's (an idiom / a phrasal verb / a proverb / a common expression).

#### Definition

- It means to [some verb].
- It means to be [some adjective].

### **Synonyms & Antonyms**

- It's another word for [some word].
- It means roughly the same thing as [some word].
- It's a synonym for [some word], but it has a (negative / positive) meaning.
- It's the opposite of [some word].

#### Register

- It's considered (formal / standard / colloquial / slang).
- It's (legal / medical / scientific) jargon.

### **Context & Usage**

- It's often used in (science / business / education).
- It's often used by (scientists / businesspeople / teachers).
- It's often found in (newspaper articles / literature / pop songs).
